ORDER NO : 126 PCB of 2019
Dated : 31 -12-2019

Whereas, in term of Bio Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2000 Authorization of the Prescribed Authority i.e Pollution Control Board is required for every institution generating, collecting, receiving, storing, transporting, treating, disposing and or handling Bio Medical Waste in any manner is essential.

Whereas, meeting of other requirements of **Bio Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rule, 2000** is also mandatory upon every Health Care Establishment like having the biomedical waste collection, segregation and treatment facility in place in the Health Care Establishment.

Whereas, obtaining of consent under Section 25 and 21 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 respectively is also mandatory for Health Care Facility.

Whereas, **M/s A.V. Nursing Home, 216(p)/2, Channi Himmat, Jammu** is presently being run in violation of above stated laws, the consent of the Board as authorization granted to the health care establishment was valid upto **March,2017** and thereafter the proprietor has failed to obtain upto date renewal besides failing to have treatment facilities in place in the Health Care Establishment.


Whereas, repeated notices were accordingly served upon the proprietor, latest served vide No. **SPCB/LSJ/806/2019/803-804 dt. 26-08-2019**, calling upon him, there under to show reasons as to why his health care Establishment be not closed down for being run without the consent/authorization of the Board and implementing Biomedical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules in breach.

Whereas, the owner of the health care facility has failed to show any tenable response, as such, the Health Care Establishment cannot be allowed to operate with above status as same shall amount to permit the operation in violation of laws governing environmental protection.

Now therefore, in exercise of powers vested in the JK Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment Protection Act and Rules made there under, immediate closure of **M/s A.V. Nursing Home, 216(p)/2, Channi Himmat, Jammu** is hereby ordered and in this behalf the :-

- i). Deputy Commissioner/District Magistrate **Jammu** is directed to immediately close down the **M/s A.V. Nursing Home, 216(p)/2, Channi Himmat, Jammu**.
- ii). Chief Engineer Electric and Maintt. Divn. (PDD) canal road Jammu is directed to snap the electric supply to the above said hospital immediately.
- iii). Director, Health Services Jammu is directed to deregister the Health Care Establishment.
- iv). Prop. **M/s A.V. Nursing Home, 216(p)/2, Channi Himmat, Jammu** is directed to case the operation of the Nursing Home forthwith.


