ORDER No. **19** -J&K PCC of 2021  
Date: **02** -06-2021

Whereas, the proprietor of M/s **Green Valley Steel Rolling Mills, IGC Lassipora, Pulwama** applied for *Consent to Operate (Renewal)* vide his online application No.1779335 dt.14-12-2020 to the J&K Pollution Control Board (**J&K Pollution Control Committee as on date**), uploading therewith copy of *Consent to Operate* (expansion) purported to be the previous consent to operate vide no. **SPCB/digital/170576935 of 2018** dt. 27-10-2018 valid upto one year i.e **October 2019** granted to the unit by the J&K Pollution Control Board.

Whereas, suspicion about genuineness of the *Consent to Operate* purported to be the previous *Consent to Operate* uploaded with the online application for consent was generated and accordingly an enquiry was conducted into the matter through a team of officers headed by the Regional Director, J&K Pollution Control Committee, Kashmir and the committee reported vide no. **PCC/RoK/LS/2021/112** dt. **16-04-2021** that a fake consent to operate No. **SPCB/digital/170576935 of 2018** dt. 27-10-2018 has been presented by the unit holder with forged signatures of officers of JKPCB including Member Secretary JKPCB.

Whereas, sufficient opportunities of being heard were provided to the unit holder by the committee to explain his position which he failed to avail and in this behalf **Sh. Rashid Dar, the proprietor of the unit** was called to appear before the enquiry committee on **16-03-2021** but he failed to cause his presence before the enquiry committee for the fake and forged consent to operate used in past and processing of the fresh consent to operate (R) case on the basis of such fake and forged consent to operate.


Whereas, the previous owner as well as present owner of the unit were finally asked to appear on **12-04-2021** to record their statements in the matter but they again choose to avoid to appear before the enquiry committee to clear their position and accordingly legal action including closure of the unit and initiation of appropriate proceedings against the owner of the unit became imperative.

Whereas, appropriate criminal action in the matter as per legal procedure is being taken separately and the unit holder is required to be prohibited from running the unit as he cannot be allowed to take advantage of the fake document (Consent to operate) for running the unit since October 2018.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested in the J&K Pollution Control Committee under **Section 33 (A)** and **Section 31(A)** of the **Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974** and the **Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981** respectively read with the **Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**, immediate closure of **M/s Green Valley Steel Rolling Mills, IGC Lassipora, Pulwama** is hereby ordered and in this behalf:-

- Deputy Commissioner / District Magistrate, Pulwama is directed to get the **M/s Green Valley Steel Rolling Mills, IGC Lassipora, Pulwama** closed immediately.
- Chief Engineer, Electric & Maintenance (PDD) Kashmir is directed to snap the electric supply to the aforementioned unit immediately.
- Director, Industries & Commerce Department, Kashmir is directed to deregister the unit.
- Proprietor of **M/s Green Valley Steel Rolling Mills, IGC Lassipora, Pulwama** is directed to cease the operation of the unit forthwith.
