ORDER NO. : 28 JK PCC of 2021
DATED : 19 -07-2021

Whereas, no industrial unit can be installed or put in operation, without prior consent of the J&K Pollution Control Committee, as warranted under **Section 25/26** and **Section 21** of the **Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974** and **Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981** respectively.

Whereas, on the basis of pollution potential, **stone crusher** is classified as **Orange** category and obtaining the consent from the Pollution Control Committee is mandatory along with adoption of pollution control mechanism to achieve the Prescribed Standards of pollution

Whereas, last consent granted to the **M/s Valley Traders at Galandar Pampore Pulwama** was valid upto **October, 2017** and presently the unit is operating illegally without consent of the J&K Pollution Control Committee.

Whereas, a stone crusher under the name and style of **M/s Valley Traders at Galandar Pampore Pulwama** is currently operational in violation of above stated laws that too without adequate pollution control devices/pollution control measures.

Whereas, the owner of the stone crusher was accordingly served with notices latest on **25-01-2021**, calling upon him there under to show reasons as to why legal action including closure of his unit be not taken to which he failed to show any tenable response, besides failing to obtain mandatory Consent from the Committee.

Whereas, the stone crusher in question cannot be allowed to run unauthorisedly with above status and to the detriment of human health and environment and Regional Director, Pollution Control Committee Kashmir has recommended the same for closure of stone crusher vide his No. **PCB/ROK/LS/2021/127 dt. 02-06-2021**.


Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested in the J & K Pollution Control Committee under **Section 33 (A)** of **Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974** and **Section 31 (A)** of the **Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981**, read with **Section 5** of **Environment (Protection) Act, 1986** immediate closure of stone crusher of Shri Abdul Aziz Mir under the name and style of **M/s Valley Traders at Galandar Pampore Pulwama**, is hereby ordered, with following directions:-

- i). The Deputy Commissioner/ District Magistrate, Pulwama is directed to get the Stone Crusher of Shri Abdul Aziz Mir under the name and style of **M/s Valley Traders at Galandar Pampore Pulwama**, closed immediately.
- ii). The Chief Engineer, Electric & Maintenance (PDD), Kashmir is directed to snap the electric supply to the above said unit.
- iii). Shri Abdul Aziz Mir, Prop. **M/s Valley Traders at Galandar Pampore Pulwama** is directed to cease the operation of the unit forthwith.
