ORDER NO.: 02 JK PCC of 2021
DATED : 21-12-2021

Whereas, no industrial can be set up and put in operation, without the prior consent of the Pollution Control Committee, as warranted under **Section 25/26** and **Section 21** of the **Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974** and **Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981** respectively.

Whereas, Dairy units fall in **Red** category on the basis of their pollution potential, for the purposes of having requisite Pollution Control Devices/Pollution Control Measures and consent from the JK Pollution Control Board / Committee.

Whereas, **M/s Panun Doudh, Bypass Lar – District Ganderbal** has been set up and put in operation in utter defiance of the above said requirements of law and the facility of ETP as basic Pollution Control Device has not been provided in the unit, which is not only violation of law but also brazen defiance of the directions of Hon'ble NGT in **O.A. No. 673/2018**.

Whereas, the unit holder was accordingly served with repeated notices, latest in the series issued on **11-01-2021** calling upon the unit holder there under to show reasons as to why legal action including closure of his unit be not taken.


Whereas, the unit holder has failed to show any response to the notices, besides failing to take measures to meet the requirements of laws governing environmental protection.


Whereas, the unit in question cannot be allowed to run un-authorizedly with above status and to the detriment of human health and environment, and accordingly Regional Director, Pollution Control Committee Kashmir vide letter No. **PCC/ROK/LS/2021/306** dt. **24-11-2021** recommended immediate closure of the unit.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested in the JK Pollution Control Committee under **Section 33(A)** and **Section 31 (A)** of the **Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974** and **Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981** respectively, read with **Environment (Protection) Act, 1986** immediate closure of Dairy unit under the name and style of **M/s Panun Doudh, Bypass Lar – District Ganderbal** is hereby ordered and in this behalf the:-

- i). Deputy Commissioner/ District Magistrate, **Ganderbal** is directed to get the Dairy unit under the name and style of **M/s Panun Doudh, Bypass Lar – District Ganderbal** closed immediately.
- ii). Chief Engineer, Electric & Maintenance (PDD) **Kashmir** is directed to snap the electric supply to the above said unit immediately.
- iii). Prop. **M/s Panun Doudh, Bypass Lar – District Ganderbal** is directed to cease the operation of the unit forthwith.
