ORDER NO.: 91 JK PCB of 2020
DATED : 15 /12/2020

Whereas closure of M/s Jain Brass Industries, 37-C, Phase-II, Gangyal Jammu was ordered by the Board vide Order No. 28 JK PCB of 2020 dated 11-09-2020, for failure of the unit holder to take adequate pollution control measures and operating the unit without pollution control devices, which is violation of environmental laws, besides detrimental to the environment and human health.


Whereas, the unit holder represented against the order of closure stating that the electricity to the unit has been disconnected by the Executive Engineer, Electric Sub-Div-IIND, JPDL, Gangyal/Shastri Nagar vide No. SD-II/502 dt. 03-10-2020 and also stated that apart from taking Pollution Prevention/Devices/ Measures in the unit, he has also applied for consent of the Board.


Whereas, the Divisional Officer, Pollution Control Board, Jammu (South) vide his No. PCB/DOJS/2020/147 dt. 15-10-2020 has reported that apart from taking Pollution Prevention Devices/ Measures in the unit, he has also applied for consent of the Board and also stated that the closure order of the unit has been implemented by the implementing agency.

Whereas, Regional Director, Pollution Control Board, Jammu vide letter No. PCB/RDJ/Consent-0/20/4629-30 dated 19-10-2020 has confirmed that besides applying for consent of the Board, the unit holder has put in place the PCDs/PCMs, and has accordingly recommended the withdrawal of closure order.

Now therefore closure order No. 28 JK PCB of 2020 dated 11-09-2020 issued against M/s Jain Brass Industries, 37-C Phase-II, Gangyal Jammu, is hereby withdrawn forthwith with the condition that the unit holder shall not operate the unit without having valid consent and hazardous waste authorization from the Board.
