ORDER No: **38**JK PCC of 2021

Dated : **17**-09-2021

Whereas, closure of **M/S Malik Cedar Wood Oil, Ward No.02, Tringala, Batote, Ramban** was ordered by the Board vide Order no. **41 JK PCB of 2020 dated 27-10-2020** for running the unit without consent of the Board and bereft of adequate pollution control devices/measures, besides undertaking the expansion of the unit unauthorizedly, as reported by the Divisional Officer Pollution Control Committee, Ramban vide his letter no. **PCB/DO/Rbn/2021/22 dt. 27-03-2021**.

Whereas, the unit holder has represented before the JK PCC for withdrawal of closure order on the plea that he has applied for obtaining Consent to Establish to the JK PCC, besides installed all the requisite PCDs / PCMs in his unit to combat the pollution.


Whereas, a committee was accordingly constituted vide no. **JK PCC/LSJ/960/2020/132-35 Dt. 27.05.2021** to verify the claims/s made by the unit holder.

Whereas, committee has submitted its report vide no. **PCC/RDJ/H-Labs/21/127 Dt. 06.08.2021** stating that unit holder has installed required APCDs/PCMs and also applied for Consent and accordingly recommended for revocation of closure order.

Whereas, Regional Director Pollution Control Committee, Jammu vide letter no. **PCC/RDJ/Consent-O/2021/3043-44 dt. 03-09-2021** confirmed the report of the Committee dt. **06-08-2021** and recommended the withdrawal of closure order.

Now, therefore, closure order no. 41 JK PCB of 2020 dated 27-10-2020 issued against **M/s Malik Cedar Wood Oil, Ward No.02, Tringala, Batote, Ramban** is hereby withdrawn subject to the condition that unit holder shall not put the unit in operation, un-till unit is consented by the J&K Pollution Control Committee.
