ORDER No. : 183 JK PCB of 2021  
DATED : 15 -03-2021

Whereas, no activity having bearing on environment can be taken in hand, without prior consent of the Pollution Control Board, as warranted under Section 25/26 and Section 21 of the Water (Prevention and Control Board) Act 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) act, 1981 respectively.

Whereas, on the basis of pollution potential, Service Stations are classified as **Orange** category and obtaining the consent from the Pollution Control Board is mandatory along with adoption of pollution control mechanism to achieve the Prescribed Standards of pollution.

Whereas, a service station under the name and style of **M/s Jammu Motors (P) Ltd., 6-Akhnoor Road, Jammu** is operational in flagrant violation of above said requirements of law as its owner has failed to obtain consent from the Board, besides failing in having Pollution Control Devices in place and functional


Whereas, the owner of the service station was accordingly served with notices particularly notice dated **12-01-2021**, calling upon him there under to show reasons as to why legal action including closure of his unit be not taken to which he failed to show any tenable response, besides failing to obtain mandatory Consent from the Board.


Whereas, the service station is presently in illegal and unauthorized operation in flagrant violation of the above stated laws that too without adequate pollution control devices/pollution control measures.

Whereas, the service station in question cannot be allowed to run unauthorisedly with above status and to the detriment of human health and environment and Regional Director, Pollution Control Board Jammu has recommended the same for closure of Service Station vide his No. **PCB/RDJ/O/2021/740-41 dt. 15-02-2021**.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested in the J&K Pollution Control Board under Section 33(A) and 31 (A) of the **Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1974** and **Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981, respectively** read with **Section 5** of the **Environment (Protection) Act 1986**, immediate closure of service station under the name and style of **M/s Jammu Motors (P) Ltd., 6-Akhnoor Road, Jammu** is hereby ordered and in this behalf the :-

- i). Deputy Commissioner/District Magistrate, **Jammu** is directed to close the service station of **Shri Sanjay Aggarwal** under the name and style of **M/s Jammu Motors (P) Ltd., 6-Akhnoor Road, Jammu** immediately.
- ii). Chief Engineer, Electric & Maintenance (PDD), canal road, **Jammu** is directed to snap the electric supply to the above said service station immediately.
- iii). **Shri Sanjay Aggarwal, Prop. M/s Jammu Motors (P) Ltd., 6-Akhnoor Road, Jammu** is directed to stop the operation of the service station forthwith.
