2.	Time limit for submission of reports of the inspections and visits carried out under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 , the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 , Env. (Protection), Act, 1986 and all the rules made there under viz. Hazardous Waste Management Rules, Bio-medical Waste Rules etc.	80-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
3.	Revised classification of industrial sector including exemption of White category of industries from taking clearances from SPCB.	81-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
4.	Differentiate compliance inspection requirements based on Industry Pollution Categorization such as Red, Amber (Orange) and Green under all Environment/Pollution Laws.	82-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
5.	Auto-renewal of Consent to Operate (under Water Act, 1974, and Air, Act 1981 based on self certification for Green Category of industries except units generating Hazardous Waste/e-Waste and requiring registration under Plastic Waste Rules .	83-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
6.	Auto-renewal of Consent to Establish (under Water Act, 1974, and Air, Act, 1981) based on self certification for all Green categories of industries except those generating hazardous waste.	84-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
7.	Regarding exemption from Environmental Compliance Inspection for Green categories of industries having satisfactory compliance history and self-attested certification of compliance of Environmental Laws.	85-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
8.	Allowing Third Party Certifications instead of Departmental Inspections under Environmental/Pollution Laws for Medium Risk Industries (Orange Categories).	86-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
9.	Submission of Consent to Establish/Consent to Operate applications for Red, Orange and Green Categories of Industries as well as cases of Authorization under Hazardous Waste Rules through Online mode only.	87-SPCB of 2018 dt. 22-05-2018.
