GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION (RENEWAL) TO OCCUPIER OR OPERATOR FOR HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTES

1. Number of authorization and date of issue 03 of 2016 dt 2.4.016
2. M/s Cadila Pharmaceuticals Ltd. is hereby granted an authorization (renewal) to operate a facility for storage and treatment of hazardous waste on the premises situated at Phase 1, IGC, Samba.
3. The authorization granted is to operate a facility for storage and treatment of hazardous waste generated from *Pharmaceutical formulation, as per revised DIC assessments vide no. MSE-J/Dev/L&M/21-III/2722-24 dt. 15/03/2016.*
4. The authorization (renewal) shall be in force for a period of **two years from the date of issue.**
5. **The authorization (renewal) issued earlier vide no. 11 of 2014 dated 24/12/2014, valid up to December 2016, is rescinded.**
6. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and Condition of Authorization

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous waste without obtaining prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board.

M/s Cadila Pharmaceuticals Ltd.

4. The applicant should maintain records of hazardous waste generated at the facility, as per "Form-3".
5. Hazardous Chemicals be stored as per the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989.
6. **The applicant should submit "Form-4" for filing returns as per Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Tran boundary) Rules 2008, by 30th June, every year for the preceding period April to March.**
7. The applicant shall make sure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling & storage as per the guidelines under rules.
8. The applicant shall conduct Mock Drills every six months and submit the details of the same to the Board.
9. The applicant shall get the samples of emission from incinerator analyzed at least once in six months and submit the report to the Board.
10. The applicant should return the empty barrels /containers to the supplier only.
11. The applicant shall maintain Material Safety Data Sheets (if any) which may be made available at the time of inspection.
12. The applicant should apply 45 days in advance for renewal of authorization before expiry of the authorization.
