**In principle approval to establish is granted to M/s GSPL India Gasnet Limited Plot No. E 18 GIDC Electronic State Nr. K 7 Circle Sector 26 Gandhi Nagar 382028 Gujrat India for laying of proposed Bathinda –Jammu Natural Gas Pipeline (BJPL) projects in Kathua and Samba districts of J&K State.**

Located in the area declared under the provisions of the Water Act / Air Act and subject to the provisions of the Act and the Rules and the Orders that may be made further and subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The Principle approval to **establish (Renewal)** the project is granted for a period up to **March 2017**.
2. The principle approval granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under laws of the land.
3. Category of the project as per UCM Guidelines: **Red**.
4. The principle approval is valid for the implementation of project with capital investment of **Rs. 127 Crore**.

1	Laying of gas pipeline in the Kathua and Samba districts of J&K

Conditions under Water Act :

- (i) The daily quantity of trade effluent from the project shall not exceed the permissible quantity approved.

- (ii) The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the project shall not exceed the permissible quantity approved.
- (iii) The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed KLD

Treatment : The company shall install a comprehensive treatment system consisting of Primary / Secondary and / or Tertiary treatment as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards before disposal.

(1) pH	Between	<u>6.5 and 8.5</u>
(2) Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	<u>100mg/L.</u>
(3) BOD, 3 days, 27°C	Not to exceed	<u>30mg/L.</u>
(4) C.O.D.	Not to exceed	<u>250mg/L.</u>
(5) Oil & Grease	Not to exceed	<u>10mg/L.</u>

(iv) Trade Effluent Disposal Outlet Conditions :

The company must ensure the safe disposal of effluent by adopting the Pollution control measures and installation of required pollution control devices as per the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and amendments made thereafter.

(v) Sewage Treatment – The company shall provide comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

pH	Between	<u>6.5 and 8.5</u>
Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	<u>100mg/l.</u>
B.O.D., 3 days, 27°C	Not to exceed	<u>30 mg/l.</u>

(vi) Sewage Disposal Outlet Conditions :

All the domestic waste water is collected in the Septic tank and soak pit

(vii) Non-hazardous solid waste (TPD./TPM): The non-hazardous solid waste should be handled and disposed as per the guidelines of Municipal Solid Waste Rules, 2000.

The company shall install a comprehensive air pollution control system consisting of control equipment as detailed below and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the level of pollutants to the following standards :

Standards for emissions of air pollution as per MOEF notification under EP Act 1986:-

(i) SPM	Not to exceed	100 ug/Nm <sup>3</sup>
(ii) SO <sub>2</sub>	Not to exceed	80 ug/Nm <sup>3</sup>
(iii) NO <sub>2</sub>	Not to exceed	80 ug/Nm <sup>3</sup>



**Condition For Noise Pollution:**

The company shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

**Other Conditions :**

- (a) **The company shall ensure that no Air pollution problem or any nuisance is created in the area due to emitting of emissions from the project activity.**
- (b) **The project activity shall not discharge any fugitive emissions. All gases shall be emitted through a stack of suitable height.**
- (c) **The company shall comply with any other condition laid down or directions issued in due course by the J & K State Pollution Control Board under the provisions of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.**

**The applicant shall comply with the additional conditions as stipulated below :**

- i. The Consent is valid for the **laying of pipeline of gas only.**
- ii. Pollution Control Devices (ETP/ECD) as contemplated to achieve the quality of effluent/ emission at the time of operation within the tolerance limits prescribed, shall have to be operational during the course of project activity . The effluent / emission shall not contain constituents in excess of the tolerance limits as laid down by J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- iii. The company shall be liable to pay compensation in case any damage is caused to the environment.
- iv. The company shall abide by the directions of the Board which will be issued from time to time. Any infringement/violation or transgression of the statutory enactments of pollution control acts by the project , shall be sufficient cause to prosecute the violator in conformity with relevant section of Air / Water Acts and Environment Protection Act in force.
- v. The project be under surveillance monitoring of J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vi. The company shall raise green belt of suitable plant species within the premises of project .
- vii. The company shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages/discharge of any air pollutant/gas/liquid from the vessel, machinery etc. which are likely to cause fire hazard including environmental pollution.

viii. Good House keeping practices shall be adopted by the company.

ix. It shall be the responsibility of the company to ensure that there are no complaints from the surrounding areas due to pollution caused by the project .

x. *In case of violation of the above mentioned conditions or any public complaint the consent shall be withdrawn.*


\* *This consent is issued purely from environmental angle and the Board shall not be responsible for any claim, counter claim, ownership, partnership etc. of the project.*

**Specific Conditions :**

1. That the company shall not undertake any construction activity for establishment of the Gas pipeline unless the company submits *detailed project report , various permissions from the concerned departments and land allotment* for issuance of consent to establish fresh .

2. As per Government of India Ministry of Environment & Forests (I.A Division) vide communication no. F.No. J-11011/200/2012-1A II(I) dated 16<sup>th</sup> January ,2013 that since 0.523 ha forest land is involved, M/s GSPL India Gasnet Limited shall obtain necessary clearances under the Forest(Conservation) Act ,1980. Other statutory clearances under the Wildlife (Protection) act, 1972, Air and Water Act and CRZ Notification as may be required in this case shall be obtained
