**GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION(RENEWAL) TO OCCUPIER OR OPERATOR FOR
HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTES**

1. Number of authorization and date of issue 609 2016 dt 30/4/2016
2. **M/s Cardinal Chemicals Pvt. Ltd.** is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for storage of hazardous waste on the premises situated at **179 A- 180 A, SICOP Industrial Area, Kathua.**
3. The authorization granted is to operate a facility for storage of hazardous waste generated from the process of manufacturing of *Fortified Rosin-2700 MTA, Neutral Sizing-4125 MTA, AKD Sizing-502 MTA, Synthetic Rosin-2500 MTA, Fiber- NAL/RTN-60 MTA, Refined ligno-250 MTA.*
4. The authorization shall be in force for a period up to **March 2017.**
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


Terms and Condition of Authorization

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous waste without obtaining prior permission of the Board.

4. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made in "Form-1" before its expiry.
5. The applicant should maintain records of hazardous waste generated at the facility, as per "Form-3".
6. The applicant should submit "Form-4" for filing returns as per Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008, by 30th June, every year for the preceding period April to March.
7. The applicant shall make sure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling & storage as per the guidelines under rule.
8. The applicant should submit the challans of empty barrels sent to supplier for re-filling, within a period of three months.
9. The applicant should reflect all the quantities of hazardous waste generated on the display Board and submit the photographic proof of the same to the Board, within a period of three months.
10. The applicant should apply 45 days in advance for renewal of authorization before expiry of the authorization.
