**GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION (RENEWAL) TO OCCUPIER OR OPERATOR FOR
HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTES**

1. Number of authorization and date of issue 51 of 2016 dt 30.4.016
2. **M/s Diamond Paints Industry** is hereby granted an authorization for storage of hazardous waste on the premises situated at **Industrial Ext. Area, Kathua.**
3. The authorization granted is for storage of hazardous waste generated during the manufacturing process of ***Distemper (1100 MTA), Snowcem (1100 MTA), Paints/Synthetic Varnish (1360 MTA).***
4. The authorization shall be in force for a period **up to January 2019.**
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and Condition of Authorization

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.

3. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made in "Form-1" before its expiry.
4. The applicant should maintain records of hazardous waste generated at the facility, as per "Form-3".
5. The applicant should submit "Form-4" for filing returns as per Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008, by 30th June, every year for the preceding period April to March, specifying liners and other waste generated also.
6. The applicant shall make sure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling & storage as per the guidelines under rules.
7. The applicant will conduct Mock Drills twice a year and submit the certificates of the same to the Board along with photographs.
8. The applicant shall submit challans of the empty barrels, sent for refilling.
9. **The applicant shall ensure that the display board is permanently filled up.**
10. **The applicant shall not use Lead in the manufacturing process, and submit an affidavit in this regard, within a period of one month.**
11. The applicant should apply 45 days in advance for renewal of authorization before expiry of the authorization.
