GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION (RENEWAL) TO OCCUPIER OR OPERATOR FOR HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTES

1. Number of authorization and date of issue 44 of 2016 dt 30.4.016
2. **M/s Chetan Alloys** is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for storage and transportation of hazardous waste on the premises situated at **163-164, SICOP Industrial Estate, Kathua.**
3. The authorization granted is to operate a facility for storage of hazardous waste generated from the process of manufacturing of ***Copper & Copper Alloy Ingots (2632.5 MTA), Zinc & Zinc Alloy Ingots (3948.75 MTA), Lead & Lead Alloy Ingots (1316.25 MTA), Aluminum & Aluminum Alloy Ingots (1316.25 MTA) and Tin & Tin Alloy Ingots (975 MTA).***
4. The authorization shall be in force for a period up to **March 2017.**
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and Condition of Authorization

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous waste without obtaining prior permission of the Board.

4. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made in "Form-1" before its expiry.
5. The applicant should maintain records of hazardous waste generated at the facility, as per "Form-3".
6. **The applicant should re-submit "Form-4" giving category and quantity wise breakup & "Form-6" for filing returns as per Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008, within a period of three months.**
7. The applicant shall make sure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling & storage as per the guidelines under rule
8. **The applicant should submit Form VII under Batteries (Management & Handling) Amendment Rules, 2010 with in a period of three months.**
9. **The applicant should submit the details of the registered firms to whom the Hazardous waste is to be sent, along with their valid consent and authorization and the transport manifests, within a period of three months.**
10. **The applicant shall submit SMR of process air quality (including parameter lead), within a period of three months.**
11. The applicant should apply 45 days in advance for renewal of authorization before expiry of the authorization.
