**GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION (RENEWAL) TO OCCUPIER OR OPERATOR FOR
HANDLING HAZARDOUS WASTES**

1. Number of authorization and date of issue 54 of 2016 dt 30.4.2016
2. **M/s Nicer Paper Mills** is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for storage of hazardous waste on the premises situated at **Industrial Estate, Ph-II, Govindsar, Kathua.**
3. The authorization granted is to operate a facility for storage of hazardous waste generated from the process of manufacturing of **Writing & Printing paper (27000 MTA).**
4. The authorization shall be in force for a period of one year from the date of issue.
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and Condition of Authorization


1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous waste without obtaining prior permission of the Board.




4. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made in "Form-1" before its expiry.
5. The applicant should maintain records of hazardous waste generated at the facility, as per "Form-3".
6. Hazardous Chemicals be stored as per the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989.
7. The applicant should re-submit "Form-4" including the details of empty barrels, as per Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008, for the preceding period April to March.
8. The applicant shall make sure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling & storage as per the guidelines under rule.
9. **The applicant shall submit Self Monitoring Report of the sludge sample within a period of three months.**
10. **The applicant shall seek prior permission from the J&K State Pollution Control Board for disposal of sludge.**
11. **The applicant shall seek Environmental Clearance from the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority, as per EIA notification vide no. S. O. 1599 (E) dated 25/06/2014.**
12. The applicant should apply 45 days in advance for renewal of authorization before expiry of the authorization.
