





GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION FOR SELLING BRANDED PRODUCTS &
IMPLEMENTATION OF EPR

1. Number of authorization and date of issue ... 24 905 dt 05-02-016
2. 'Lava International Ltd., A-56, sector-64, Noida, U.P. is hereby granted an authorization as Producer under E-waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2011 for selling branded products & implementation of Extended Producer Responsibility in the State.
3. The authorization is provided for collection and channelization of end-of-life equipments under its brand or generated during repair from all service centres to registered recycler through collection point in the name and style of "M/s Next G Solutions, 128-130, sector-6, lane-8, Nanak Nagar, Jammu".
4. The authorization shall be in force for a period of **one year** from the date of issuance of this certificate.
5. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and such conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and conditions of authorization (General)

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization / its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the e-waste without obtaining prior permission of the state Pollution Control Board.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.

5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the operations.
6. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made as laid down in sub-rule (6) of rule 9 before 60 days of its expiry.
7. The applicant shall ensure that e-waste shall be collected from all retail outlets, service centres and will be sent to the **Collection point** identified by company only in a secured manner.
8. The applicant shall ensure that no damage is caused to the environment during storage and transportation of e-waste.
9. The applicant shall raise awareness about the **Collection point** identified by the company and provide details such as address, telephone no./helpline no., e-mail etc. of such **Collection point** to the general public in the State.
10. The Producer shall raise awareness about the e-waste by adopting any suitable means of mass communication besides website and shall get printed the necessary logo as under E-waste Rules on all of its Products range.
11. The documentary proof of the above shall be submitted to SPCB while filing annual returns.
12. The Producer shall maintain records of e-waste handled in Form 2 to be available for scrutiny by State Pollution Control Board.
13. The Producer shall submit annual returns to SPCB in Form 3 on or before 30th of June every year.
14. The Collection points can store e-waste for a maximum period of 180 days which may be extended up to one year in exceptional cases in the States which do not have any registered dismantling or recycling facility.
