## CONSENT ORDER

SPCB 282 of 2017 dated 24-5-2017

Consent to Operate (Fresh for additional line of activity) under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended is granted in favour of Mrs. Samreen Shafi (Prop.)

**M/s Safa Filling Station  
Baghi Ali Mardan Industrial Estate Nowshara Srinagar**

for a period upto **One year from date of issue** for **Orange** category of unit as per revised classification of industrial sector, subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner:

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent is granted valid for the operation of servicing the vehicles with capital investment as per schedule II **Rs. 24.10 lacs (additional cost)**

The emissions or discharge of environmental pollutants from the service station shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards for the said industry, operation or process specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 as amended from time to time.

### 3. Compliance under Water Act :

#### a. Standards of discharge for Trade Effluent :

**Treatment :** The service station owner has to operate and maintain a comprehensive effluent treatment system consisting of Primary / Secondary and / or Tertiary treatment so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards :

| Parameters            | Conc. in mg/l except for pH |
|-----------------------|-----------------------------|
| PH                    | 6.5-8.5                     |
| Suspended Solids      | 100                         |
| BOD(3 days at 270 c ) | 30                          |
| COD                   | 250                         |
| Oil & Grease          | 10                          |

#### b. Standards of discharge for Sewerage disposal :

**Sewage Treatment** – The service station owner has to install a comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

| Parameters        | Range         | Conc. in mg/l except for pH |
|-------------------|---------------|-----------------------------|
| pH                | between       | 6-9                         |
| Suspended Solids  | Not to exceed | 100                         |
| BOD, 3 days, 27°C | Not to exceed | 30                          |

- c. All the domestic waste water is disposed off through septic tank and soakage pit. Trade effluent is disposed off through effluent treatment plant.

#### d. Water consumption

- i. The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the unit shall not exceed the permissible limit.
- ii. The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed 01 KLD.



#### 4. Compliance under Air Act:

a. The service station owner shall comply to **National Ambient Air Quality Standards** as per EP Act 1986 (refer rule 3(3B) .

#### 5. Compliance under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules 2000 as amended

The service station owner shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

#### 6. Pollution Control Equipments & Measures :

The unit holder has to operate and maintain a comprehensive water pollution control system i.e. Sedimentation tank to achieve the quality of effluents within the tolerance limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986

#### 6. Self Monitoring Schedule :

The service station owner shall get the samples of treated effluents analysed from the J&K SPCB laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report by March 2018 for ascertaining the efficacy of pollution control devices to check the quality of effluent as per limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.

#### 7. The service station owner shall comply with the additional conditions as stipulated below :-

- i. The Consent is valid for the **Operation of service station only**.
- ii. The service station owner can service/ repair only items as mentioned in consent order. Pollution Control Devices (ETP/ECD) as contemplated to achieve the quality of effluent within the tolerance limits prescribed, shall have to be operational during the course of servicing / repairing of vehicles .
- iii. The effluent shall not contain constituents in excess of the tolerance limits as laid down by J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- iv. The service station owner shall be liable to pay compensation in case any damage is caused to the environment.
- v. The service station owner shall abide by the directions of the Board which will be issued from time to time.
- vi. Any infringement/violation or transgression of the statutory enactments of pollution control acts by the unit, shall be sufficient cause to prosecute the violator in conformity with relevant section of Air / Water Acts and Environment Protection Act in force. The service station shall be under surveillance monitoring of J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vii. The service station owner shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages/discharge of any air pollutant/gas/liquid from the vessel, machinery etc. which are likely to cause fire hazard including environmental pollution.
- viii. This consent is issued subject to condition that unit holder shall install effluent treatment plant for the treatment of waste water generated
- ix. The service station owner should apply 60 days in advance for renewal of consent before expiry the date of this Consent order.
- x. In case of violation of above mentioned conditions or any public complaint the consent shall be withdrawn.

\* This consent is issued purely from environmental angle and the Board shall not be responsible for any claim, counter claim, ownership, partnership etc. of the unit. .
