

Terms and Condition of Authorization


1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.

3. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made in "Form-1" before its expiry.
4. The applicant should maintain records of hazardous waste generated at the facility, as per "Form-3".
5. The applicant should submit "Form-4" for filing returns as per Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008, by 30th June, every year for the preceding period April to March.
6. The applicant shall make sure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling & storage as per the guidelines under rules
7. The applicant should apply 45 days in advance for renewal of authorization before expiry of the authorization.
