**CONSENT ORDER**

SPCB <sup>460</sup>-----of 2017 dated 10.07.017

Consent to Establish (Fresh) under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended is granted in favour of

Mr. Ghulam Hassan Sayeed

**M/s Max Car Service Station,  
Bemina, near degree college, Srinagar.**

for a period of **one year** from the date of issuance of this consent for **Orange** category of unit as per revised classification of industrial sector, subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner:

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent granted is valid for servicing and washing of vehicles with below mentioned consented quantity having capital investment (as per schedule II) **Rs. 10.88 lacs**. Any change / enhancement in the line of activity, process, and raw materials shall have to be intimated to the Board and service station owner has to apply fresh for the same.

S.No.	Activity	Maximum Quantity
1	Washing, Servicing and repairs of vehicles	15-20 vehicles/day

The emissions or discharge of environmental pollutants from the unit / establishment shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards for the said industry, operation or process specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 as amended from time to time.

**3. Compliance under Water Act :**

**a. Standards of discharge for Trade Effluent :**

**Treatment** – the service station owner has to install a comprehensive effluent treatment system consisting of Primary / Secondary and / or Tertiary treatment so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards of discharge outlet:

Parameters	Conc. in mg/l except pH
pH	6.5 – 8.5
Suspended Solids	100
BOD (3 days at 27°C)	30
COD	250
Oil & Grease	10

**b. Standards of discharge for Sewerage disposal:**

**Sewage Treatment** – The applicant has to install a comprehensive sewage treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

Parameters	Range	Conc. in mg/l except pH
pH	Between	6-9
Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100
BOD, (3 days at 27°C)	Not to exceed	30

- c. All the domestic waste water is disposed off through septic tank and soakage pit. Trade effluent is disposed off through effluent treatment plant.

d. **Water consumption**

- i. The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the unit shall not exceed the approved permissible limits
- ii. The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed 3 KLD.
- a. The service station owner shall comply to **National Ambient Air Quality Standards** as per EP Act 1986 (refer rule 3(3B)).

4. **Compliance under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules 2000 as amended**

The service station owner shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

6. **Pollution Control Equipments & Measures:**

The service station owner has to operate and maintain a comprehensive water / air pollution control system at the time of operation of unit as applicable under environment protection act 1986


7. **Self Monitoring Schedule:**

The service station owner shall get the samples of treated effluent / emission analyzed from the J&K SPCB laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report within six months from the date of issuance of this consent for ascertaining the efficacy of pollution control devices to check the quality of effluent under environment protection Act, 1986, failing which the consent shall be deemed as withdrawn and if the SMR submitted by the unit holder does not certify the norms prescribed under EP Act, 1986, the consent shall be processed for withdrawal and further necessary action shall follow as per codal formalities.


8. **The service station owner shall comply with the additional conditions as stipulated below:-**

- i. The Consent is valid for the **establishment of washing cum Service Station only.**
- ii. Pollution Control Devices (ETP/ECD) as contemplated to achieve the quality of emission / effluent within the tolerance limits prescribed, shall have to be operational during the course of production. The emission effluent shall not contain constituents in excess of the tolerance limits as laid down under the guidelines of EP Act.
- iii. The service station owner shall be liable to pay compensation in case any damage is caused to the environment.
- iv. The service station owner shall abide by the directions of the Board which will be issued from time to time. Any infringement/violation or transgression of the statutory enactments of pollution control acts by the unit shall be sufficient cause to prosecute the violator in conformity with relevant section of Air / Water Acts and Environment Protection Act in force.
- v. The unit shall be under surveillance monitoring of J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vi. The service station owner shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages/discharge of any air pollutant/gas/liquid from the vessel, machinery etc. which are likely to cause fire hazard including environmental pollution.
- vii. The service station owner should apply 60 days in advance for renewal of consent before expiry the date of this Consent order.
- viii. In case of violation of above mentioned conditions or any public complaint the consent shall be withdrawn.
- ix. The service station owner shall not operate the service station unless and until he obtains Consent to Operate from the Board.

\* This consent is issued purely from environmental angle and the Board shall not be responsible for any claim, counter claim, ownership, partnership etc. of the unit.
