CONSENT ORDER

SPCB 500 of 2017 dated 3-8-2017

Consent to Establish / Operate (Fresh) under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended is granted in favour of Sh. R. K Suri (Chairman)

M/s Institute of Dental Sciences
Village Seora Kunjwani Bishnah Road Jammu

for a period upto **One year from date of issue** for a category of **Red** as per revised classification of industrial sector, subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner:

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent is granted for establishment and operation of Health Care Establishment (Dental college) under with capital investment as per schedule II **Rs. 20.63 Crore**.

The emissions or discharge of environmental pollutants from the establishment shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as amended from time to time.

3. Compliance under Water Act :

a. Effluent standards of discharge of treated effluent

Treatment : The HCE authority has to operate and maintain a comprehensive effluent treatment system consisting of Primary / Secondary and / or Tertiary treatment so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards of discharge outlet.

Parameters	Conc. in mg/l except for pH
PH	6.5-8.5
Suspended Solids	100
BOD(3 days at 27° c)	30
COD	250
Oil & Grease	10

b. Standards for discharge of sewerage treatment

Sewage Treatment – The HCE authority has to install a comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

Parameters	Range	Standards of discharge
pH	between	6-9
Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100 mg/l
BOD, 3 days, 27°C	Not to exceed	30 mg/l

c. All the domestic waste water is disposed off through sewerage treatment plant .

d. Water consumption

- i. The daily quantity of trade effluent from the HCE shall not exceed KLD
- ii. The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the HCE shall not exceed KLD
- iii. The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed 22.25 metric cube per day .

4. Compliance under Air Act:

- a. The entrepreneur shall comply to **National Ambient Air Quality Standards** as per EP Act 1986 (refer rule 3(3B) .
- b. The HCE authority shall adhere to emission standards of Incineration as notified in EP Act.

5. Compliance under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules 2000 as amended

The HCE authority shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

5. Compliance under Plastic Waste Management Rules 2016 dated 18-3-2016.

6. Compliance under Bio Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 1986.

7. Pollution Control Equipments & Measures :

The HCE has to operate and maintain a comprehensive Pollution Control System to achieve the quality of emission / effluent within the tolerance limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.

8. Self Monitoring Schedule :

HCE authority shall get the samples of treated emissions and effluents analysed from the J&K SPCB laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report of emission / effluent by June 2018 for ascertaining the efficacy of pollution control devices to check the quality of parameters as per limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.


9. The applicant shall comply with the additional conditions as stipulated below :-

- i. The Consent is valid for the Establishment / **Operation of HCE only.**
- ii. Pollution Control Devices (ETP/ECD) as contemplated to achieve the quality of effluent / emission within the tolerance limits prescribed, shall have to be operational during the course of production. The effluent / emission shall not contain constituents in excess of the tolerance limits as laid down by J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- iii. The HCE authority shall be liable to pay compensation in case any damage is caused to the environment.
- iv. The HCE authority shall abide by the directions of the Board which will be issued from time to time. Any infringement/violation or transgression of the statutory enactments of pollution control acts by the HCE, shall be sufficient cause to prosecute the violator in conformity with relevant section of Air / Water Acts and Environment Protection Act in force
- v. The HCE authority shall be under surveillance monitoring of J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vi. Any further construction /expansion / renovation / in the HCE premises shall be subject to the clearance from the J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vii. The HCE authority shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages/discharge of any air pollutant/gas/liquid from the vessel, machinery etc. which are likely to cause fire hazard including environmental pollution.
- viii. The HCE authority should apply 60 days in advance for renewal of consent before expiry the date of this Consent order.
- ix. Specific conditions:


- a. The Health Care Establishment shall follow the Bio Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 1989 and as amended thereof.
- b. The Health Care Establishment shall place different receptacle with color coding for collection of Bio Medical Waste .

- xi. **In case of violation of above mentioned conditions or any public complaint the consent shall be withdrawn.**
