CONSENT ORDER

SPCB --511--of 2017 dated -31-8-2017

Consent to **Operate (Fresh)** under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act,1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act,1981, as amended is granted in favour of

**M/s Project Manager , PIU-JKUSDIP
J&K ERA 13 C / C Gandhi Nagar Jammu**

for a period upto **One year from date of issue** for **Red** category of unit as per revised classification of industrial sector, subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner:

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent is granted valid for the operation of sewerage treatment plant with capital investment as per schedule II **Rs. 20 Crore** .

1	Sewerage treatment plant at <i>Gola Bagwati Nagar Jm</i>	30 MLD

The discharge of environmental pollutants from the sewerage treatment plant shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Rules , 1986 as amended from time to time.

3. Compliance under Water Act :

a. Standards of discharge for Sewerage disposal:

Sewage Treatment – The executive agency has to install a comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

Parameters	Range	Conc. in mg/l except for pH
pH	between	6-9
Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100
BOD, 3 days, 27°C	Not to exceed	30

b. All the sewage effluent is disposed off through sewerage treatment plant .

c. Water consumption

- i. The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the STP shall not exceed 30 MLD.
- ii. The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed 05 KLD

4. Compliance under Air Act:

a. The executive agency shall comply to **National Ambient Air Quality Standards** as per EP Act 1986 (refer rule 3(3B) .

5. Pollution Control Equipments & Measures :

The executive agency has to operate and maintain a comprehensive water pollution control system as applicable under EP Act to achieve the quality of effluent within the tolerance limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.

6. Compliance under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules 2000 as amended

The executive agency shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

5. **Self Monitoring Schedule :** The executive agency shall get the samples of treated effluents analysed from the J&K SPCB laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report within 3 months for ascertaining the efficacy of pollution control devices to check the quality of effluent as per limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.


6. **The executive agency shall comply with the additional conditions as stipulated below :-**

- i. The Consent is valid for the Operation of sewerage treatment plant only as per the prescribed standards notified under EP Act.
- ii. The executive agency has to keep a record of the Environmental data monitored regularly with regard to operation and maintenance of sewerage treatment plant to achieve the desired standards notified in EP Act.
- iii. Pollution Control Devices (STP) as contemplated to achieve the quality of effluent within the tolerance limits prescribed shall have to be operational during the course of operation. The effluent shall not contain constituents in excess of the tolerance limits as per the standards laid down by J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- iv. The executive agency shall be liable to pay compensation in case any damage is caused to the environment.
- v. The executive agency shall abide by the directions of the Board which will be issued from time to time. Any infringement/violation or transgression of the statutory enactments of pollution control acts by the agency shall be sufficient cause to prosecute the violator in conformity with relevant section of Air / Water Acts and Environment Protection Act in force.
- vi. The sewerage treatment plant shall be under surveillance monitoring of J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vii. The executive agency should apply 60 days in advance for renewal of consent before expiry of the date of this Consent order.
- viii. **Specific conditions :**

The executive agency shall submit adequacy of sewerage treatment plant after getting sample analyzed from Board's laboratory or laboratories approved by State Pollution Control Board within three months positively failing which an action under Environment Protection Act 1986 Central Pollution Control Board shall be taken.

- ix. In case of violation of above mentioned conditions or any public complaint the consent shall be withdrawn.
