AUTHORIZATION IS GRANTED UNDER RULE 6(2) OF THE HAZARDOUS & OTHER WASTES (MANAGEMENT & TRANSBOUNDARY MOVEMENT) RULES 2016

1. Number of authorization and date of issue----- 112 of 2017 dt. 31/8/2017

3. **Sh. P.K Aggarwal (General Manager) of M/s UPL Limited Situated at IGC Ph I SIDCO Samba** is hereby granted an authorization for interstate disposal of **incinerable hazardous wastes** to Common Hazardous Waste Treatment and Disposal Facility (TSDF) in the name & style of M/s Bharat Oil and Waste Management Ltd. Located at GATA No. 672 village Kumbhi NH 2 Kanpur –Dehat 290101 (U.P) for incineration at their site for final disposal.



- (1). The authorization is valid for a period upto **March 2018**.
- (2). The authorization is subject to the following general & specific conditions:


General Conditions Of Authorization:

1. The authorized person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an Officer authorized by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorization.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel equipment as working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
5. The person authorized shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorization is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time.
6. The person authorized shall comply with the provisions outlines in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on "implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty.
7. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its cleanup operation.
8. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other wastes shall be maintained.
9. The hazardous and other waste which gets generated during recycling or reuse or recovery or pre-processing or utilization of imported hazardous or other wastes shall be treated and disposed of as per specific conditions of authorization.
10. The importer or exporter shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages, if any.
11. by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
12. **Annual return shall be filed by June, 30th for the period ensuring 31st March of the year.**
13. The unit holder shall also seek authorization from the concerned Board where the facility exist.

Specific Condition: The authorization is only for interstate transportation disposal of incinerable hazardous waste to the site namely M/s Bharat Oil and Waste Management Ltd. Located at GATA No. 672 village Kumbhi NH 2 Kanpur –Dehat 290101 (U.P) and the unit holder shall follow all the norms and provision of hazardous waste rules 2016 and shall transport the hazardous waste in safe mode as prescribed under hazardous waste rules 2016 following all codal procedures , otherwise an action as warranted under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 , dt: 4-4-2016 shall be taken against the unit holder and party carrying hazardous waste read with EP Act 1986.
