CONSENT ORDER

SPCB --- 527 --- of 2017 dated 21-9-2017

Consent to **Establish (Renewal)** under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended is granted in favour of Managing Director

M/s J&K State Industrial Development Corporation Ltd.
4th Floor Udyog Bhawan Rail Head Complex Jammu

for a period upto **March 2018** for **Red** category of unit as per revised classification of industrial sector, subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner:

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent is granted valid for the establishment of Industrial Growth Centre at SIDCO Industrial Complex with capital investment as per schedule II **Rs. 204.80 Crore**.

S.No.	Facility
1	Establishment of Industrial Growth Centre at SIDCO Industrial Complex Ghatti, Kathua to establish units under White, Green, and selective Orange category.

The emissions or discharge of environmental pollutants from the units / establishment shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards for the specific industry operation or process specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 as amended from time to time.

3. Compliance under Water Act :

a. Effluent standards of discharge of treated effluent

Treatment : The unit holder has to operate and maintain a comprehensive effluent treatment system consisting of Primary / Secondary and / or Tertiary treatment so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards of discharge outlet.

Parameters	Conc. in mg/l except for pH
pH	6.5-8.5
Suspended Solids	100
BOD(3 days at 27 ^o c)	30
COD	250
Oil & Grease	10

b. Standards for discharge of sewerage treatment

Sewage Treatment - The unit holder has to install a comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

Parameters	Range	Standards of discharge
pH	between	6-9
Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100 mg/l
BOD, 3 days, 27 ^o C	Not to exceed	30 mg/l

c. All the domestic waste water is disposed off through common effluent treatment plant .

d. Water consumption

- i. The daily quantity of trade effluent from the unit shall not exceed KLD
- ii. The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the unit shall not exceed KLD
- iii. The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed 589 KLD.

4. Compliance under Air Act:

- a. The unit holder shall comply to **National Ambient Air Quality Standards** as per EP Act 1986 (refer rule 3(3B) .
- b. The unit holder has to operate stack(s) of the following specifications at the time of operation of unit .

5. Pollution Control Equipments & Measures :

The unit holder has to operate and maintain a comprehensive pollution control system as applicable under Water / Air Act to achieve the quality of emission / effluent within the tolerance limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.

6. Compliance under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules 2000 as amended

The unit holder shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

7. Compliance under Plastic Waste Management Rules 2016 dated 18-3-2016.

8. Self Monitoring Schedule : The unit holder shall get the samples of treated emissions and effluents analysed from the J&K SPCB laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report when unit becomes operational to check the quality of emission / effluent as per limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.

9. The applicant shall comply with the additional conditions as stipulated below :-

- i. The Consent is valid for the **Establishment of unit only**. The unit holder can only manufacture products, at the rate of production as mentioned in consent order.
- ii. Pollution Control Devices (ETP/ECD) as contemplated to achieve the quality of effluent emission within the tolerance limits prescribed, shall have to be operational during the course of production. The effluent / emission shall not contain constituents in excess of the tolerance limits as laid down by J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- iii. The unit holder shall be liable to pay compensation in case any damage is caused to the environment.
- iv. The unit holder shall abide by the directions of the Board which will be issued from time to time. Any infringement/violation or transgression of the statutory enactments of pollution control acts by the unit, shall be sufficient cause to prosecute the violator in conformity with relevant section of Air / Water Acts and Environment Protection Act in force.
- v. The unit shall be under surveillance monitoring of J & K State Pollution Control Board.
- vi. The unit holder shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages/discharge of any air pollutant/gas/liquid from the vessel, machinery etc. which are likely to cause fire hazard including environmental pollution.
- vii. The entrepreneur should apply 60 days in advance for renewal of consent before expiry the date of this Consent order.
- viii. Specific condition:

- a. That only these category of industrial units shall be allotted land those approved by the Ministry of Environment and Forests , New Delhi.
- b. That individual unit shall take permission individually for consent to establish as per Water / Air Act .

- ix.
- x. The unit holder shall not operate the unit unless Board issue consent to operate fresh.
- xi. In case of violation of above mentioned conditions or any public complaint the consent shall be withdrawn.

*** This consent is issued purely from environmental angle and the Board shall not be responsible for any claim, counter claim, ownership, partnership etc. of the unit.**
