**CONSENT ORDER**

SPCB **552** of 2017 dated **11-11-2017**

Consent to **Operate (Renewal)** under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended is granted in favour of

for a period upto **March-2018** for a category of unit **Red** as per revised classification of industrial sector) subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner :-

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution as per Water and Air Act only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent is granted for the manufacturing of the following quantities of products / by-products consented as under with capital investment as per DPR. Further any change / enhancement in production capacity , process , raw materials shall have be intimated to the board and unit holder has to apply fresh for the same.

1	Extraction of Lime Stone	Over an area of 48 Hectare

3. The emissions or discharge of environmental pollutants from the unit/ establishment shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards for the said industry, operation or process specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Rules , 1986 as amended from time to time.

**The Consent is issued subject to the following Conditions:**

1. That no. blasting shall be done to affect the Geomorphology of the rock and disturbance of BIO-mass only drilling / Chiseling/Manual operation for lime stone only shall be allowed. In case blasting is involved lessee has to seek the permission from concerned authority.
2. Fugitive Dust emissions (SPM & RSPM) from all sources should be controlled regularly monitored. Water spraying arrangements on haul roads, wagger loading, dump trucks (loading & unloading) pts should be provided properly maintained.
3. That in case of any damage/adverse impact to the environment or if the activity is associated with any disturbances to the environment, the objection certification (NOC) shall be treated as cancelled.
4. This certificate is restricted to extraction of lime stone to the area mentioned as above, any extraction beyond that area shall be at the risk & responsibility of the lessee for which action as per provision of EP Act shall be taken. The entrepreneur shall conform to provisions under Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 Air (P&CP) Act 1981 and Environment Protection Act, 1986 before coming into commercial production.
5. That this NOC is to facilitate the unit holder to take up lease of the area as per mining act applicable and not prejudice to mandate of Geology and Mining Department.
6. The Waste (workshop & waste water from the mine generated, if any) should be properly collected, treated so as to conform to the standards prescribed issued by MoEF, GoI, New Delhi.
7. A Green Belt of adequate with by planting the native species should be raised around the leased area, township, roads OB dump site etc, in consultation with the Local Divisional Forest Officer/Agriculture Department. The density of the trees should be at least 2500 plants/ha. That the lessee will cover at least 30% of the total mining area under dense plantation within a period of 2 years from the date of issuance of the NOC in his favour.
8. The stage-wise reclamation programmed in the lease hold area should be implemented. The land reclamation & black filling should be carried out concurrently with the mining activity.
9. Personnel working in dusty areas should wear protective respiratory devices and they should also be provided with adequate training and information on safety and health aspects.
10. The top Soil and OB dumps should be stacked in earmarked dump sites only.
11. Fugitive emission should be controlled & regularly monitored. Adequate measures for control of fugitive emissions should be taken during drilling operation, loading & transportation of material.
12. Adequate measures should be taken for control of noise level below 75 db (A) in the work environment.



13. Workers engaged in drilling, chiseling, blasting operation etc. should be provide wither plugs/muffs & safety measures.
14. Failure to comply with any conditions mentioned above could result in withdrawn of this Environmental Clearances.
15. An adequate arrangement of waster is to be made at the site for dust suppression during operation plantation & treatment waste water generated from the use of water at site.
16. **No mining shall be carried out in the Wildlife / Forest Area.**
17. Major approach road and haul roads shall be metal topped.
18. Drill should be wet operated only.
19. The Company shall obtain approval of Central Ground Waste Authority/Board for use of Ground Water is any for mining operation.
20. No change in mining technology and scope of working should be made without prior approval of the India Bureau of Mines.
21. The above condition will be enforced inter-allia under the provisions of the Water (Prevention and control of Pollution Act, 1974 Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1981. Environmental (Protection) Act 1986 public liability insurance Act 1991 along with their amendments and rules.
23. That the unit holder will maintain a safe & protective area of not less than 500 matsr from the demarcated Forest / Wildlife protected area/Conservation Zones as a buffer strip.
24. That the project proponent will restrict mining activity to granted area only and leave rest of the area for the dense plantation green belt development.
25. Self Monitoring Schedule:- The unit holder shall get the samples of treated emissions and effluents analysed from the &K SPCB Laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report within six months from the date of issue of consent.


**Specific conditions:-**

- i. That Consent is issued subject to compliance of specific condition **(A)** of the Environment Clearance granted by MoEF and is subject to clearance of the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife and as per the condition of Environmental Clearance issued by the Ministry or Environment and Forests Delhi vide No. J-11015/253/2008-IA.II(M) dt. 9-12-2009
- ii. That unit holder shall not carry out any extraction of lime in any Eco sensitive zone & Wildlife area under Forest Conservation Act, the consent is issued only to facilitate and seek mandatory clearances of wildlife.
- iii. That unit holder shall comply to the conditions of the environmental conditions issued vide no. J-11015/253/2008-IA.II(M) dt. 9-12-2009 and submit compliance report to the Regional Office periodically after every six months.
- iv. This NOC is issued to facilitate other pending clearance in other related departments and shall not be final till all the clearance is sought by the unit holder.
- v. That unit holder shall follow the conditions of EMP and the conditions issued under the mining lease granted by Industrial Department (Director Geology & mining) vide govt. Order No. 277 IND of 2008 dt. 30-10-2008.
- vi. The consent is issued to seek the clearness of Wildlife from the standing Committee of National Wildlife Board
