CONSENT ORDER

SPCB 557 of 2017 dated 06-12-2017

Consent to **Operate (Fresh)** under section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, as amended is granted in favour of

for a period upto **December 2018** for category of **Red** as per revised classification of industrial sector, subject to the following terms and conditions in a time bound manner:

1. The consent granted by the Board is restricted to Prevention and Control of Pollution only and shall not be treated as substitute of permission required under other laws of the land.
2. The consent is granted valid for the bottling of LPG Gas cylinders consented quantity as under with capital investment as per schedule II **Rs. 9900 lacs**. Any change / enhancement in production capacity, process, raw materials shall have to be intimated to the board and unit holder has to apply fresh for the same

The emissions or discharge of environmental pollutants from the unit / establishment shall not exceed the relevant parameters and standards for the said unit, operation or process specified under respective schedules of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 as amended from time to time.

3. Compliance under Water Act :

a. Standards of discharge for Sewerage disposal:

Sewage Treatment – The corporation has to install a comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to effluent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards before disposal :-

Parameters	Range	Standards of discharge
pH	between	6-9
Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100 mg/l
BOD, 3 days, 27°C	Not to exceed	30 mg/l

b. All the domestic waste water is disposed off through septic tank and soakage pit.

c. Water consumption

- i. The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the unit shall not exceed KLD
- ii. The daily quantity of water consumption shall not exceed KLD.

4. Compliance under Air Act:

5. The corporation shall comply to **National Ambient Air Quality Standards** as per EP Act 1986 (refer rule 3(3B)).

6. Pollution Control Equipments & Measures :

The corporation shall operate Fire fighting equipments, install sand buckets and water storage tanks etc as prescribed under environment protection act 1986.

7. Compliance under Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules 2000 as amended

The corporation shall take adequate measures for control of noise from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standards in respect of noise to less than 75 db(A) during day time and 70 db(A) during night time. Daytime is reckoned in between 6am to 10pm and night time is 10pm to 6am.

8. **Self Monitoring Schedule** : The corporation shall get the samples of treated emissions analysed from the J&K SPCB laboratory or laboratory approved by the J&K SPCB and submit self monitoring report by October 2018 for ascertaining the efficacy of pollution control devices to check the quality of emission as per limits prescribed under environment protection act 1986.
