

With a view to bring the Govt. run Health Care Facilities (Hospitals) in the ambit of consent mechanism of the Board, one time relaxation of Consent fee to these hospitals operational for decades on non-commercial and non-profit basis is hereby accorded with following details with immediate effect, as approved by the Board in its **33<sup>rd</sup> Board Meeting**.

1.	Hospitals having 500 beds and above	15000/-	7500/-
2.	Hospitals having 200 beds and above but < 500 beds.	12000/-	6000/-
3.	Hospital having 50 beds and above but < 200 beds.	10000/-	5000/-
